

2015—2016 STUDENT FELLOWSHIP APPLICATION

Fellowship Description:

Four or five Student Fellowships are awarded by the College of the Environment's Governing Board each semester. Student Fellows are offered shared office space in the College of the Environment (COE). Student Fellows are expected to participate in the Think Tank Discussion at the COE as well as attend the Schumann lecture series, the Where On Earth Are We Going Symposium and the Earth Day Keynote Address. Course credit can be arranged for a student's participation as a Fellow.

Applicants for a Student Fellowship must be planning to do a senior capstone project (e.g., honors thesis, senior essay, choreography, etc.) on a topic related to the Center theme for the year. The project need not be underway at the time of the application.

Applications must be received by the Center for the Humanities no later than Friday, April 10, 2015. They will be reviewed by the COE Governing Board and the selected Faculty Fellows. Notification of the Advisory Board's decision will be made April 24, 2015.
