RACHEL ANN LEWIS

Rachel Ann Lewis is associate professor of women and gender studies at George Mason University. Her research addresses issues of sexuality, race, disability, and immigration in transnational contexts. Professor Lewis is currently at work on two book manuscripts: *Deportable Subjects: Lesbians and the Political Asylum Process*, which examines claims for asylum, refugee status, and human rights by lesbian subjects; and *Queer Intimacies: Visualizing Black Lesbian Desire in Post-Apartheid South Africa*, which examines media and cultural advocacy produced by lesbian, intersex, and transgender human rights activists in South Africa.
