**REQUIREMENTS:** To be admitted to the major as a single major, you must have completed at least one government course with a grade of B- or better, and you must have formally completed Stage 1 of the General Education Expectations. If in the current semester you are enrolled in your first Government class, and your professor certifies by email that you are earning a B- or better; or if in the current semester you are enrolled in a course which, if completed successfully, would result in your satisfaction of Stage I of the General Education Expectations, you can be admitted provisionally to the major. Your status will be reviewed at the end of the semester. If at that time you have not met the B- and Stage I requirements, you will be required to drop the major.

To be admitted to the major as a double major you must satisfy the above requirements as well as an additional requirement: your academic history must show that you have a university GPA of 88.33 or above. To maintain the Government major as a double major, you must maintain or exceed an 88.33 university GPA at the end of each semester through the end of the first semester of your senior year. Double majors will be required to drop the major if at any time the academic history shows a cumulative GPA of 88.32 or below.
