

Graduate Housing

Eligibility

Housing at Wesleyan is limited and the Office of Residential Life only provides housing to graduate students who are currently enrolled in a graduate program and their immediate family members (domestic partners/spouses and children or legal dependents). Evidence of marriage or domestic partnership is required for married or partnered students to be considered for family housing.

Process

Assignments are made on a yearly basis based on available vacancies and roommate preferences (if applicable). For incoming graduate students, housing assignments will be sent via email by July 30 if the Office of Residential Life receives the housing application by June 30. After the above deadline, any additional requests for housing are processed on a first-come, first served basis, based on the remaining availability.

Lease

Students must sign a binding lease with the University upon receiving keys for their unit. Signing the lease indicates an agreement to live in Graduate Housing for the duration of one academic year. All leases end on May 31 of each year.
