

Dear Class of 2015:

It is university policy that seniors cannot charge to their student account after classes end for the spring semester. Seniors with **private** insurance who receive “in-house” services with a fee (see below) at the Davison Health Center (DHC) will have charges go directly to their student account from March 24 to May 6. Private insurance **will not** be billed for these specific services during this time since reimbursement claims may not arrive for reconciliation by graduation. After May 6 seniors will need to pay cash or check for in-house services as charges cannot be made to student account. Visit fees will continue to be billed directly to insurance until the end of the semester. Please note: This policy does not apply to students with Gallagher student insurance.

Laboratory testing sent to directly to Clinical Lab Partners will continue to be billed through private and student insurance for the duration of the semester.

Students with private insurance who would like to file their own claim for reimbursement should ask for a statement of services rendered for in-house testing.

Please speak with your DHC healthcare provider at the time of visit if you have any questions. Please note that all charges to student accounts are recorded as miscellaneous health center fees.
