The Application Process

Vassar students should check with the Office of International Programs for the specific application deadline in early December of the academic year preceding the academic year in which they wish to study abroad.

Wesleyan students and students from other institutions: applications must be received by February 15 for the following fall semester and full year, by October 1 for the following spring semester.

A complete application includes:

1. Application form
2. 250-word essay in French
3. Language evaluation form
4. Letter of recommendation from a non-language instructor
5. A copy of your transcript (not required for Vassar or Wesleyan students)
6. A letter of approval of participation from your dean or study abroad advisor (not required for Vassar or Wesleyan students)
7. A \$25 application fee (not required for Vassar or Wesleyan students)
