General Housing Information:

- Most first year students live in a double room
- All first years may preference to live in an all first-year hall, mixed population hall with sophomores, or in a Community Based Living environment (CBLV).

- Two room doubles available
- Single Sex Floor

- 130 residents
- Traditional 1st year residence hall
- All double rooms
