The Office of Academic Affairs has limited funding to support departmental "One-Day Retreats." These are single-day retreats, generally used to prepare for external reviews, in which members of Wesleyan academic units (departments, programs, colleges, or centers) meet to discuss issues of curricular renewal, pedagogy, and the future of the unit.
