

SAMPLE SCHEDULE 4

This is the schedule for a student that is considering applying to medical school after their FOURTH year of college. This schedule would prepare the student for the MCAT for a late spring test date in their fourth year.

We encourage students to incorporate coursework that will prepare them for the 'Psychological, Social, and Biological Foundations of Behavior' section of the MCAT. This could entail courses in Psychology, Sociology, Science in Society, and possibly Anthropology. Take a look at the Health Studies Cluster to gain an idea of a number of health related courses offered on campus. Additionally, students will need to complete a year of ENGL for most health professional programs. Medical Schools classify acceptable ENGL courses as those that encompass Composition and Rhetoric, Creative Writing and Literature.
