



## Summary of Operating Requirements

- 1. Unit must have a cover that is easily operable with one hand.**
- 2. Parts must be enclosed under the cover while draining. Drain cleaned parts for at least 15 seconds or until dripping stops, whichever is longer.**
- 3. Close cover when parts are not being handled or when the device is not in use.**
- 4. Solvent spray must be a solid fluid stream and NOT a fine mist or shower. Conduct all spraying within the confines of the unit at a pressure less than 10 p.s.i.**
- 5. Minimize drafts across the top of the cleaning unit to greatly decrease evaporation into the atmosphere.**
- 6. Do NOT operate the unit if there is any visible solvent leak; have the unit repaired promptly.**
- 7. Waste degreasing solvent must be stored in a tightly covered container to minimize evaporation into the atmosphere to the greatest extent possible.**
- 8. Maintain a monthly record of the amount of solvent added to the unit. Keep records on file for a minimum of 5 years.**
