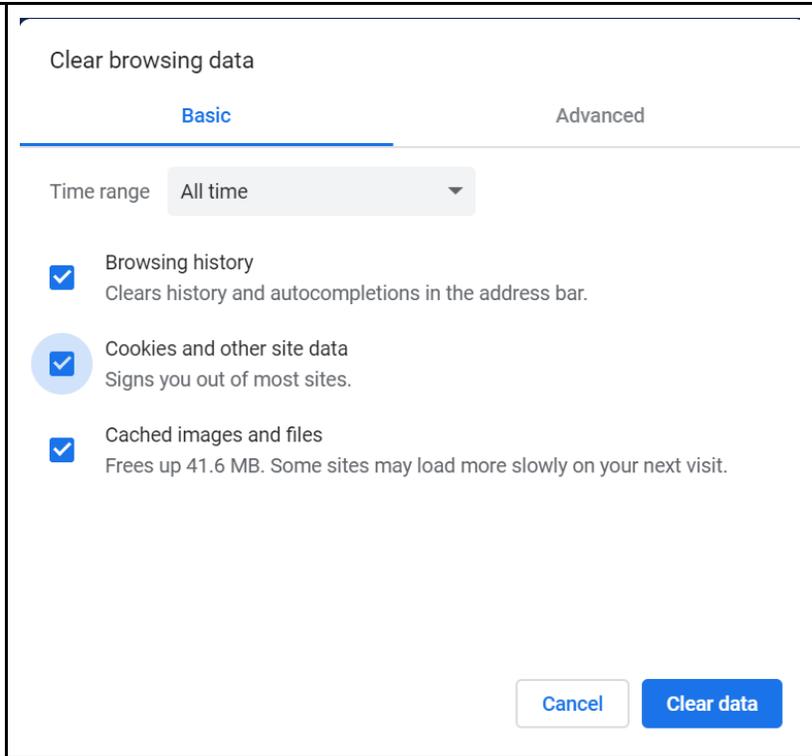
## 1. Firefox

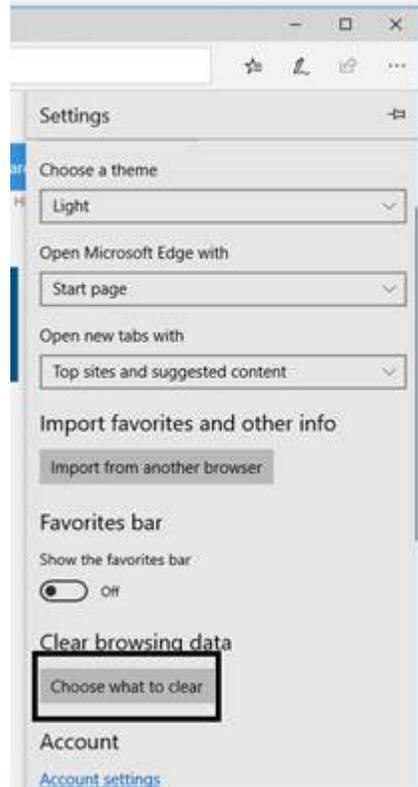
