Billable Services:

Physical plant performs routine and general maintenance of campus buildings and grounds. Major Maintenance projects are funded separately, approved in advance, and based on priority. These projects are posted on our [web page](#). Any work which exceeds routine or Major Maintenance is billable to the requesting department.

At the customer’s request, physical plant will provide a written estimate, in advance, for all billable services. The customer may request that physical plant solicit competitive bids from outside contractors and may select who will complete their requested work. Projects performed by outside contractors will be billed directly to the department.

Some examples of billable services include:

- Adding, eliminating or relocating utilities or architectural components (i.e. walls, doors, heating, ventilation, air conditioning, refrigeration, appliances, etc.)
- Replacing finishes within a space that are not scheduled for replacement through routine or Major Maintenance (i.e. painting, flooring, etc.)

- Installation of furniture, hanging of pictures and/or shelving, relocating fixtures or lab equipment, event set-up/tear-down, event coverage
