APPLICATION PROCESS FOR MA PROGRAM

All of the following materials must be submitted for the application to be considered complete. Please note which items are to be submitted by email or by postal mail.

The following materials must be submitted as **separate attachments in one email** to <u>icpp@wesleyan.edu</u> no later than 11:59pm ET on January 15, 2020. The subject line of this email must **be the applicant's full legal name.**


- Application for admission (this form) You must save this completed form with the file name LASTNAME_2020APPLICATION.PDF
- 2. Application essay/statement of purpose (up to 5 pages) The application essay/statement of purpose should include information about your professional and academic background, abilities, interests and objectives; what attracted you to the ICPP MA; your research experience (if any); and why you feel Wesleyan's ICPP MA program is suited to your academic and professional goals. You must save this document as a PDF with the file name LASTNAME_2020ESSAY.PDF
- 3. Writing Sample (10-15 pages) The writing sample should be an example of your best scholarly writing; it can be an excerpt from a larger piece, but should be understandable as a stand-alone; you may also submit multiple writing samples but the total number of pages should be 15 or less.

You must save this document as a PDF with the file name LASTNAME_2020WRITINGSAMPLE.PDF

- 4. **Current CV** You must save this document as a PDF with the file name LASTNAME_2020CV.PDF
- 5. **TOEFL** is required if the applicant's native language is not English. You must save this document as a PDF with the file name LASTNAME_2020TOEFL.PDF

The following materials should be submitted by email to <u>icpp@wesleyan.edu</u> no later than 11:59pm ET on January 15, 2020. Letters should be emailed directly from the person providing the recommendation from their professional, verifiable email (i.e @wesleyan.edu) with the subject line "Letter of Recommendation: APPLICANTLASTNAME".

1. Two letters of recommendation One should be a letter from a current or recent employer or someone else who can address the applicant's career goals and capabilities; one should be from a former professor or someone who can speak to the applicant's ability to succeed in a program of academic rigor.



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The following materials should be submitted by postal mail directly from the degree granting institution to the ICPP office by January 15, 2020: ICPP c/o Center for the Arts, 283 Washington Terrace, Middletown, CT 06459

1. Official transcript(s) from all degree granting institutions of higher learning.
