

Latin American Studies Major Status Sheet

Ten semester courses are required to complete the LAST major: six in LAST and four in a department of concentration (e.g., History, Government, Hispanic Languages and Cultures). Of the six LAST courses, at least four must be taken at Wesleyan. At least two of the six LAST courses must be cross-listed with SBS departments at Wesleyan and at least two must be cross-listed with HA departments at Wesleyan. Of the two courses cross-listed with HA departments, one must be LAST 226, Survey of Latin American Literature, Cultures, and Ideas. To graduate as a LAST major, a student must also satisfy the LAST research requirement by writing a thesis, essay, or paper that is centrally concerned with Latin America and is (a) on a topic of the major's own choosing, (b) 20+ pages, and (c) graded B- or better. LAST majors must also complete Stage II of the General Education Expectations.
