Randall MacLowry is an award-winning filmmaker who crafts documentaries and non-fiction media projects through The Film Posse, the production company he co-founded with his wife and business partner Tracy Heather Strain. A director, writer, producer and editor with over 30 years of experience, MacLowry's credits include films for the PBS series *American Experience*, most recently "American Oz," "The Feud," "The Swamp" and "The Battle of Chosin," *NOVA*, *American Masters*, *Unnatural Causes: Is Inequality Making Us Sick?*, and *Race: The Power of an Illusion*. With Strain, MacLowry produced and edited the critically acclaimed *Lorraine Hansberry: Sighted Eyes/Feeling Heart*, which had its world premiere at the 2017 Toronto International Film Festival and won a Peabody Award. MacLowry has received two Writers Guild awards, and two of his *American Experience* films won the Organization for American Historians' Erik Barnouw Award. MacLowry serves on the faculty of Wesleyan University's College of Film and the Moving Image.
