Please use the Checklist to ensure that you return all required materials by their deadlines. [WesMaps](#) is Wesleyan’s online course catalog and provides scheduling information and course descriptions for classes that will be offered in the Spring 2019.

Transfer Student Orientation begins on Tuesday, January 22, 2019 and continues through Wednesday, January 23. This is an important time for you to become familiar with the campus and make new friends. I will meet with you individually to address any concerns or questions you may have. **You are expected you to arrive on campus between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon on Tuesday, January 22.** If you anticipate a problem with this arrival time, please let me know as soon as possible.

To support your in this transition, we will match you with a student who recently transferred to Wesleyan through the Transfer Connection Program.
