#### **September**

- O **Thursday, September 1**<sup>st</sup> Registration deadline for the October 1 SAT.
- O As soon as you get back to school, check in with your recommenders in person. Make sure they have everything they need.
- O As soon as you get back to school, ask a trusted English teacher to read your college essay and give you feedback.
- O Saturday, September 10th ACT test day
- O **Friday, September 16<sup>th</sup>** Registration deadline for October 22 ACT. Ask your guidance counselor/career center for a fee waiver (tell them you are a part of Upward Bound Math-Science).
- O Check in with Miguel or Marek on your progress. You should be doing this throughout the process. CHECK YOUR EMAIL!
- O During September you should set up a meeting with you guidance counselor regarding the application process.
  - Set up an appointment with counselor as soon as you get back to school.
  - Ask about what they need from you in order to release your records to schools. What is the procedure? How to submit recommendations?
  - o Share your list with them. <u>DO NOT</u> let them bully you off your list.
- O You should have a finalized list of where you will be applying to by the end of the month.
- O Continue working on Common App, and begin to work on applications for schools not using the Common App.
- O Visit colleges

#### **October**

- O **Thursday, October 1**<sup>st</sup> Deadline to meet with your guidance counselor (for at least the first time). You should have already done this by now.
- O Begin completing the CSS Profile through collegeboard.com if you are applying to schools that need it. The Profile is longer and more invasive than the FAFSA. If you want/need help with it, please make an appointment with Marek or Miguel.
- O You can start the FAFSA this month. Ask Marek or Miguel for assistance.
- **Saturday, October 1st** SAT test day.

J	Ask Miguel or Marek for an SAT Fee Waiver for November SAT (you are allowed 2 waivers).
0	<b>Friday, October 7</b> <sup>th</sup> – Registration deadline for the November 5 SAT
0	Saturday, October 22 <sup>nd</sup> – ACT test day
0	Check in with Marek or Miguel on your progress. You should be doing this throughout the process. CHECK YOUR EMAIL!
0	College list should be complete
0	Recommendations should be complete. If not, remind your teacher(s) and other recommenders.  o Depending on your school (ask your counselor!) and where you are applying to your recommenders may have to submit their letters by a certain date.
0	You should be completing the Common App. <u>Meet with Marek or Miguel to review before submission</u> .
0	Put any final touches on your essay

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#### **December**

- O **Tuesday, December 1**<sup>st</sup> Recommended submission deadline for all applications.
  - O <u>You need to meet with Marek or Miguel to review applications before you</u> submit them.
  - O Get everything you need to your guidance counselor.
  - O Follow whatever procedure your school has to release your records.
  - O Make sure you release your SAT scores to the schools that need them.
- O Check in with Marek or Miguel to finalize your applications. Make sure you've clicked SUBMIT on all apps and received confirmation that everything went through.
- O Follow-up with schools to make sure they received everything. Check your e-mail! Look out for correspondence from admissions offices.
- O Submit the CSS Profile for schools that require it
- O Submit the FAFSA. Schedule an appointment with Marek or Miguel for assistance.
- O Continue scholarship search
- O Visit colleges
