Jennifer Flackett has been a screenwriter, producer and director in both television and film for over twenty-five years, working with her husband and partner Mark Levin. Netflix's BIG MOUTH, which Jennifer co-created and executive produces, premiered its fourth season on Netflix in December 2020. The show is picked up through season six. Production has begun on her new Netflix animated show HUMAN RESOURCES, a workplace comedy set in the world of the monsters from BIG MOUTH, co-created with Nick Kroll, Andrew Goldberg, Mark Levin and Kelly Galuska.

In film, Flackett & Levin wrote MADELINE, WIMBLEDON, THE PERFECT STORM, and JOURNEY TO THE CENTER OF THE EARTH 3-D. Their Blacklisted script THE ADAM PROJECT has just wrapped production with Netflix and Skydance, and it stars Ryan Reynolds, Jennifer Garner and Mark Ruffalo. Flackett and Levin also wrote and directed the films LITTLE MANHATTAN and NIM'S ISLAND.

In television, Jennifer began her writing career on iconic shows like BEVERLY HILLS 90210 and LA LAW. Along with Kroll and Goldberg, Levin & Flackett founded the animation company BRUTUS PINK which produces animation exclusively for Netflix.
