WESLEYAN UNIVERSITY MAJOR DEFERRAL PETITION

According to the Academic Review and Promotion section in the Academic Regulations in the <u>Academic Catalog</u>, students **must declare their major during their fourth semester of enrollment.** Students not accepted into a major by the end of their fourth semester must complete a Major Deferral Petition in order to be permitted to enroll for their fifth semester.

In compelling and exceptional situations, students may petition for an exception to this policy by using this Major Deferral Petition form.

For example, students can petition for a deferral because they are currently completing a major entry requirement. Students deferring major declaration will need to determine an advisor for the remainder of the semester and an alternate major in which there is progress and that can be completed by graduation.

This petition must be submitted to the class dean prior to returning to campus to start the fifth semester.
